- No exhibit to be removed before 4.30 p.m.** unless permission is given by the Secretary . **Tents to be cleared by 5.00 p.m.**
- Prize money must be claimed between 4.30 p.m. & 5.00pm on presentation of Winners' tickets at the Horticultural Marquee.
- Cups to be returned to Secretary **14 DAYS** before next show
- Competitors may enter more than one exhibit in any class.
- All classes listed are open to all persons except those restricted by age.
- Members of the Committee shall be entitled to enter, subject to the same Rules.
- Entrance fee shall be 50p per entry for Horticulture, Homecraft & Photography classes...Classes 72-98 are free.
- All exhibits are to be grown by, made by and be the sole property of the exhibitor.
- Tent classes. Any objections to exhibits must be lodged with the Secretary by 3.30 p.m. Such objections will be dealt with by a Special Committee whose decision will be final. A deposit of £5.00 to be paid by objector, to be refunded if the objection is sustained.
